Principals Report

Alan Lammers gave a slide presentation

Welcome to 2010/2011 school year theme of the year is continue the mission

Strive to be a mission and not an organization emphasized

Student information system progressing

This year is reaccreditation year which means

- Chance to learn about school
- Encouraged to be fresh set of eyes
- Keep working on communication especially through technology
- Teachers coordinating how to better and more effectively communicate between each other. Also stated if requires dialog then face to face encouraged.

Alan Lammers presented Student Information System features including

Grades

Attendance

Lunch bills

Registration

Discipline

Stated that there will be one web portal for each family with multiple students. "One place to see all children "

Teachers being set up currently so they can show grades

Lunch accounting system will show the current balance

Alan Lammers presented on Teachers/Mission based core

70 different competencies for teachers of which 8 are mandatory to fulfill the mission

Stated still working on student literacy and prayer, encouraging growth and change.

Faculty is encouraged to participate in bible study each month.

School will undergo a self study process. Each standard will have a sub committee, Ferris Pfeiffer will be leading and will start soon.

Under Mr. Pfeiffer leadership the team will verify, report and make new recommendations. They will add this information to the self study and go to the school board.

NEW BUISNESS

Linda Runnabaum presented the New Fund Request form and process.

Angie Esser spoke about MU Concessions and that approx. \$5,000.00 is profited from the endeavor

Currently has 6 different groups and more volunteering encouraged to meet demand.

"Its fun"

Football concession approved and with 6 games expected profit is \$1000.00 per game.

Angie Esser presented that must be 16 years old to work and that any unaffiliated volunteers can work.

Voted by show of hands to agree to Football game concession participation.

Linda Runnebaum stated that the first installment to church \$13,200.
approved

Alan Lammers requesting a 10% increase in funding to parish and stated that 80% of Parrish budget taken by school.

Alan Lammers explained Parrish needs more funding and that there were new objections from Parrish council to slow down. Programs for church may be removed.

Motion to increase contributions to church
